### GOOD REASONS TO VISIT

- A history lesson and open-air memorial site.
- A veritable green lung boasting spectacular panoramic views at the heart of the Hauts-de-France region.

**The Château of Coucy and its fortress are among the largest fortified structures in France. Spanning some 14 hectares, Coucy boasted no fewer than 33 towers and over 2,000 metres of ramparts.**

The château's four corner towers were almost the size of the royal keep at the Louvre, while its keep was the largest tower in the entire Christian West.

Moved by the château's fate, architect Eugène Viollet-le-Duc took advantage of his restoration campaign at Pierrefonds to save the building in an attempt to remedy the ravages of time. Both the château and indeed the region as a whole were severely tested by the trials of

World War I, but the spectacular ruins of this majestic château are nevertheless fascinating.

#### ***DID YOU KNOW...?***

Perched on a rocky outcrop, Coucy is a wonderful garden of ruins that also boasts incredible panoramic views across the Axon plains.
